Comment from John Maher:

There are three things to be aware of for your closing cover:

- 1. Stocking rate: higher stocking rate will have a high demand for grass
- 2. Wet/ dry farm: wetter/ mixed farms may find it difficult to graze some paddocks in spring. A slightly lower cover is 500 to 600 kg DM/ha is acceptable for these farms.
- 3. Calving date but more importantly calving rate: having a high calving rate will require large amount of grass in spring.
