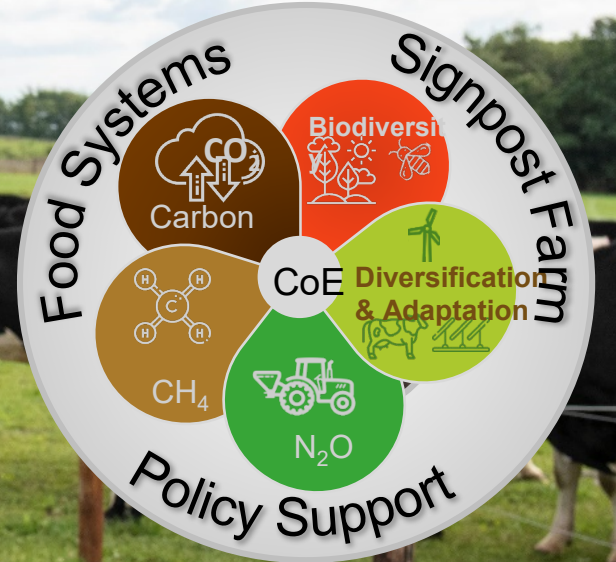

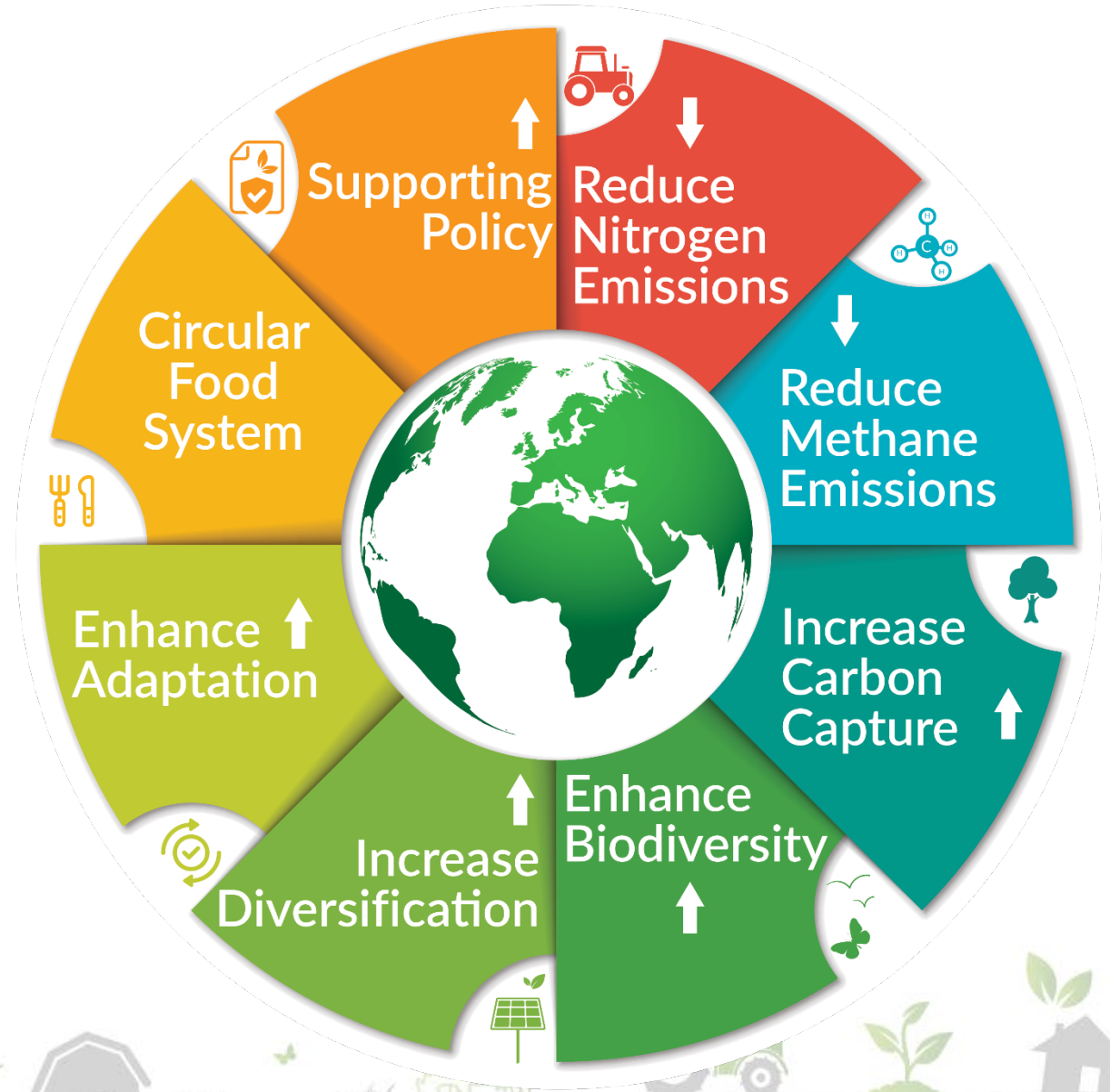
What will the National Centre for Agri-Food Climate Research & Innovation look like?

What will be the key areas of action within the Centre?

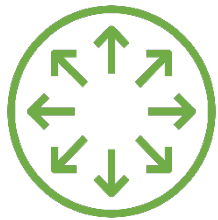


Advantages of the Virtual Centre in Climate Change

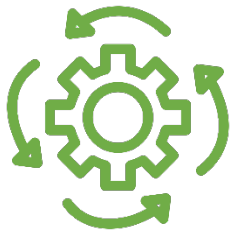
Advantages of the Virtual Centre in Climate Change
