# What is cow flow?

Cow flow is the movement
 of a herd of cows to and
 through the milking parlour
 from where they have been
 feeding and resting. This
 movement needs to be
 smooth and efficient.



## Cow Track

- Width (fenced 0.5m from edge)
- Surface
- Camber



## Collecting Yard / Milking Parlour

- Yard
- Size (1.5m sq-1.8m sq)
- Shape
- Surface
- Backing gate
- Parlour
- Natural light
- 90°turns
- Surface
- Milking routine



#### Human Interaction / Behaviour

- Droving the cows from the field (cows heads up / heads down)
- Moving cows in and out of parlour
- Farmer's behaviour during milking



#### Summary

- Observe cow flow at a distance (cows heads up / heads down)
- Check your track
- Look in the mirror (Selfreflection)
