

Intro & Farm Background

- 1996 2012 : 25 cow mixed farm to 90 cows (organic growth)
- 2013 -2020 : 90 -100 cows OAD .
- Farming 45 hectares of land (34 Ha milking platform)
- 100 spring calving cows (High EBI Friesian)
- Medium / clayey soil type lands
- Fragmented farm with, steep climbs, 1.5 kms walking distance to farthest paddocks with 200 ft incline from yard.
- Contract rearing of heifers cow only dairy farm
- 10 unit herringbone, 120 cubicles on farm
- Target herd size: 110 cows

Farm Layout



Transition to OAD & Why?

- Commenced OAD in March 2013 (88 cows)
- WHY ?
- Combination of occurrences public road surface deterioration, increase in road traffic, increase in cow no.s, increase in cow fatigue / lameness, long working days, milk lorry collection times, farming enthusiasm low.......
- Transition: attended 1st OAD farm walk in 2012 = "eureka moment", spring 2013 made decision, end of March full O.A.D.
- No going back
- Now OAD milking 7.30am (2.5 hrs at peak yield)
- Typical day finish time varies a lot but with great flexibility
