
## Johnstown Castle Winter Milk Herd- Weekly Management Notes - 21/03/16

- We had a great week of dry weather for the past week, which allowed us to get a good clean off of the heavier paddocks on the soft ground, we grazed fulltime for the past 10 days, but with the relatively poor growth we have very few high covers left & have caught up well on our spring rotation plan, we'll be supplementing with silage & concentrate probably till near the end of the 1<sup>st</sup> round which we're now targeting at 05/04/16. Total rainfall for the past week was just 0.3mm, soil temperatures were similar to last week at 7.3 °C.
- All second round of fertiliser has gone out, next round targeted for the first week of April. With the good ground conditions of the past week we've been following the cows with 2,000 gal of slurry/ac.
- All replacement stock were turned out last week, we're behind our target area grazed on the replacement unit as a lot of the ground was very wet, we'll stay grazing if conditions allow, but have no problem with rehousing stock if conditions get too wet again. Priority group are the spring bulling heifers, which we'd like to keep at grass.
- The spring cows are still slow calving but most of the remainder are starting to spring up 88% calved. Bulk tank protein % have lifted considerably with more grass in the diet, although having to supplement with silage again in the coming week won't help.
