
Johnstown Castle Winter Milk Herd- Weekly Management Notes

06/06/16

- Another great week in terms of weather, no rainfall for the 7 day period, Sunday to Sunday, but we were lucky that we got 9.3mm in the form of heavy thundery downpours yesterday (bank holiday Monday), this should help growth, which was beginning to come under pressure in terms of soil moisture. Average soil temperature for the past week was a massive 19.3 °C. We have no real high covers, but plan to skip a couple of the stemmier paddocks, provided we get some more rain later this week which is forecast we should have adequate grass without these.
- We continue to spread 25-30kgsN/ha every 3 weeks on the grazing ground. With quite a few paddocks having been baled off for surplus over the past month, the need for topping has been reduced, some paddocks have been topped.
- Cow milk yield & solids have dropped slightly this week but we'd be happy with that given the natural drop off in autumn herd as they approach 250 days in milk & also grass quality over the past 10 days whilst ok could have been better.
