Appendix A

Demonstration of the Incentive Effect and Proportionate Aid

Applicable to Large Companies only

Incentive Effect

Support under this scheme is 100% exchequer funded and can only be regarded as compatible with the internal market, if it has an incentive effect. An incentive effect is present when the aid changes the behaviour of an undertaking in a way it engages in additional activity contributing to the development of the sector which it would not have engaged in without the aid or would only have engaged in such activity in a restricted or different manner. The aid must not subsidise the costs of an activity that an undertaking would have incurred in any event and must not compensate for the normal business risk of an economic activity.

Large Companies must provide documentary evidence of the incentive effect in order to be eligible for support under this scheme. The EU defines a large company as one with a headcount of more than 250 people; turnover greater than €50m; or a balance sheet greater than €43m. If a company is part of a group, the employee, turnover, annual balance sheet and ownership limits apply to the group. It is up to the applicant to properly declare themselves as a large company. The Definition of micro, small and medium-sized enterprises is recorded in Annex I of Agriculture Block Exemption Regulation (ABER). Failure to make an accurate declaration may result in the immediate cessation of aid along with the recovery of all aid which has been given along with interest at the appropriate rate.

Large companies must submit an internal company document (separate to the Form 1) showing that the company has analysed the viability of the project – with and without aid – and showing the "incentive effect". The document must clearly state what would have happened without the support available under this scheme. That means that the documentation (internal report) produced by the company must establish that the aid will cause at least one of the following:

- A material increase in the size of the project, or
- A material increase in the scope of the project, or
- A material increase in the total amount spent on the project,

The Forest Service requires that the company document shows a credible analysis and demonstration of the incentive effect. The document should contain an analysis which answers the following questions:

- Would the project proceed without State Aid assistance?
- Would the level of project expenditure be less without State Aid support? If so, indicate by how much?

This information should indicate changes in the project size, scope and total spend.

This incentive effect document should be submitted with the Form 1. The application will only be deemed to have been accepted as valid once the company has been advised by the Forest Service that the incentive document meets the requirements set out above and is fully compliant with the European Union Guidelines for state aid in the agriculture and forestry sector and in rural areas 2014 – 2020.

Proportionate Aid

Aid granted under this scheme must be proportionate. Support is considered proportional only if the same result could not be achieved with less aid, in other words if the amount of aid is limited to the minimum

necessary. The aid amount should not exceed the minimum necessary to render the project sufficiently profitable, for example should not lead to increase its IRR beyond the normal rates of return applied by the undertaking concerned in other investment projects of a similar kind or, when available, to increase its IRR beyond the cost of capital of the undertaking as a whole or beyond the rates of return commonly observed in the sector concerned. For example the IRR should be comparable with returns experienced by entities which are not large companies. Where the IRR exceeds this reference figure then the application may be refused.

Large Companies must provide documentary evidence that the aid is proportionate. This can be achieved by submitting an IRR and NPV analysis of the investment with aid and without aid with the Form 1. Only aplications which are deemed proportionate will be grant aided by the Forest Service.

Appendix B

All applications for financial support must be accompanied by a business plan, under the following headings:

1. Project Title

2. Introduction

➤ Background information and development history of the proposal; justification for establishing the proposed Seed Orchard, including current and forecasted supply in domestic production for the species concerned, as well as knowledge and understanding of the subject matter.

3. Description

➤ Provide a detailed description of the work to be carried out, including a description of the main tasks, plot layout, methodologies employed for maximising seed production and collection, and any other information that describes the proposal

4. Objectives and Targets

> Provide details of the objectives of the main tasks of the project, along with overall project targets.

5. Project Team

> Summarise the role and experience of each partner involved on the project and the relevance of each partner to the project

6. Project Management

- Provide a description of the responsibilities and co-ordination of the project, including
 - allocation of tasks
 - work programme
 - links with other projects

7. Financial

Provide a schedule of total projected expenditure (itemised) and all sources of finance for the investment.

8. Timescale

All applications should be accompanied by a Gantt Chart detailing the start and end date for each task of the project and important interim milestones. This timeline is important for budgetary purposes so the timescale/duration submitted should be as accurate as possible.
