



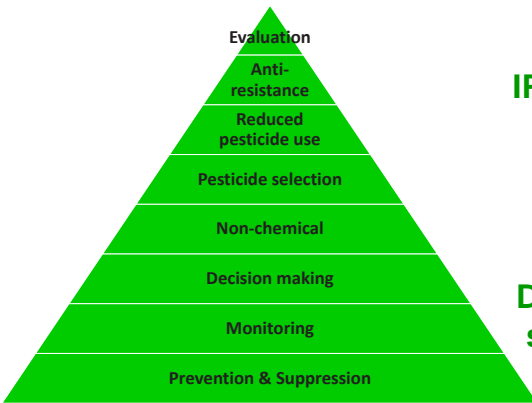
Integrated Pest Management

What is IPM?

The utilisation of all available control measures to reduce impacts of pests on cropping systems

Why use IPM?

Increasing need to manage effective pest control resources in sustainable manner

IPM is a knowledge based process

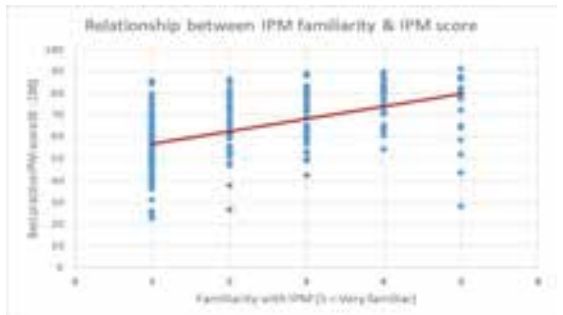
Increasing IPM on arable farms
