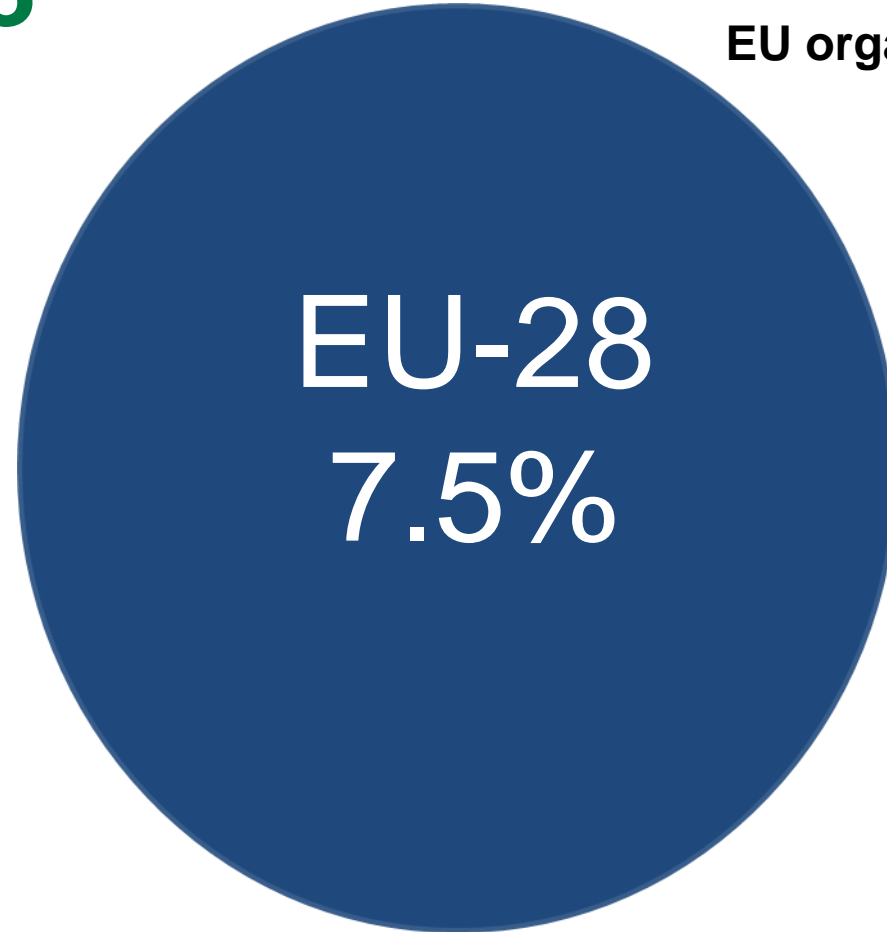

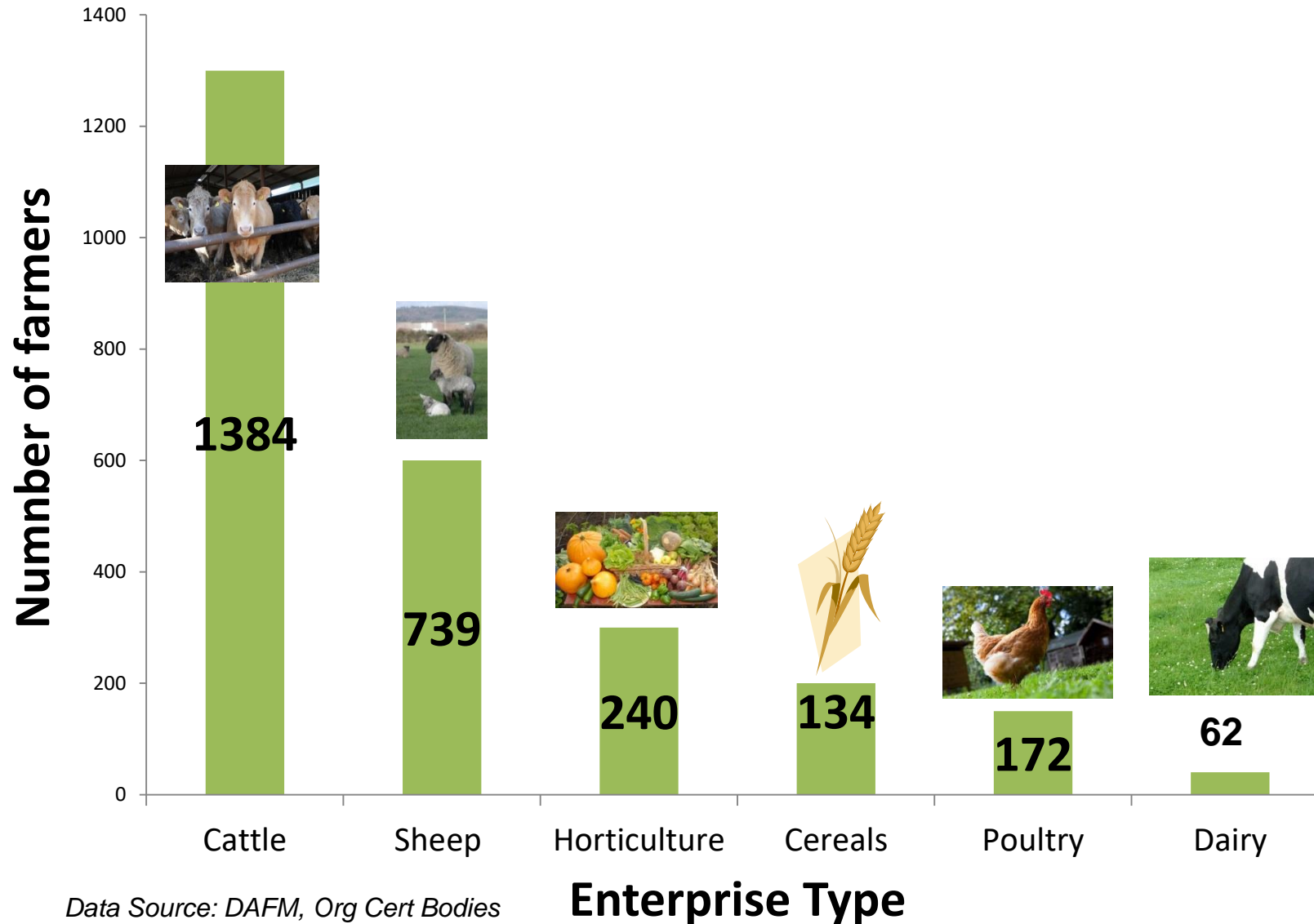
# Organic Land Area 2018



EU organic logo



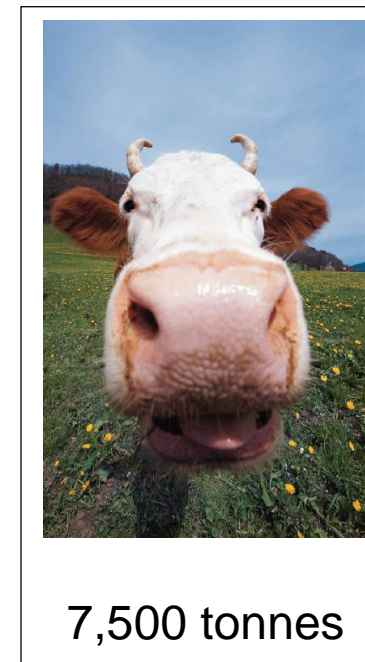
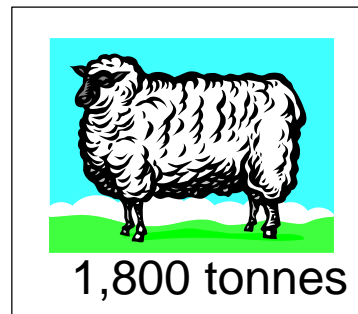
# PROFILE OF IRISH ORGANIC PRODUCTION 2019



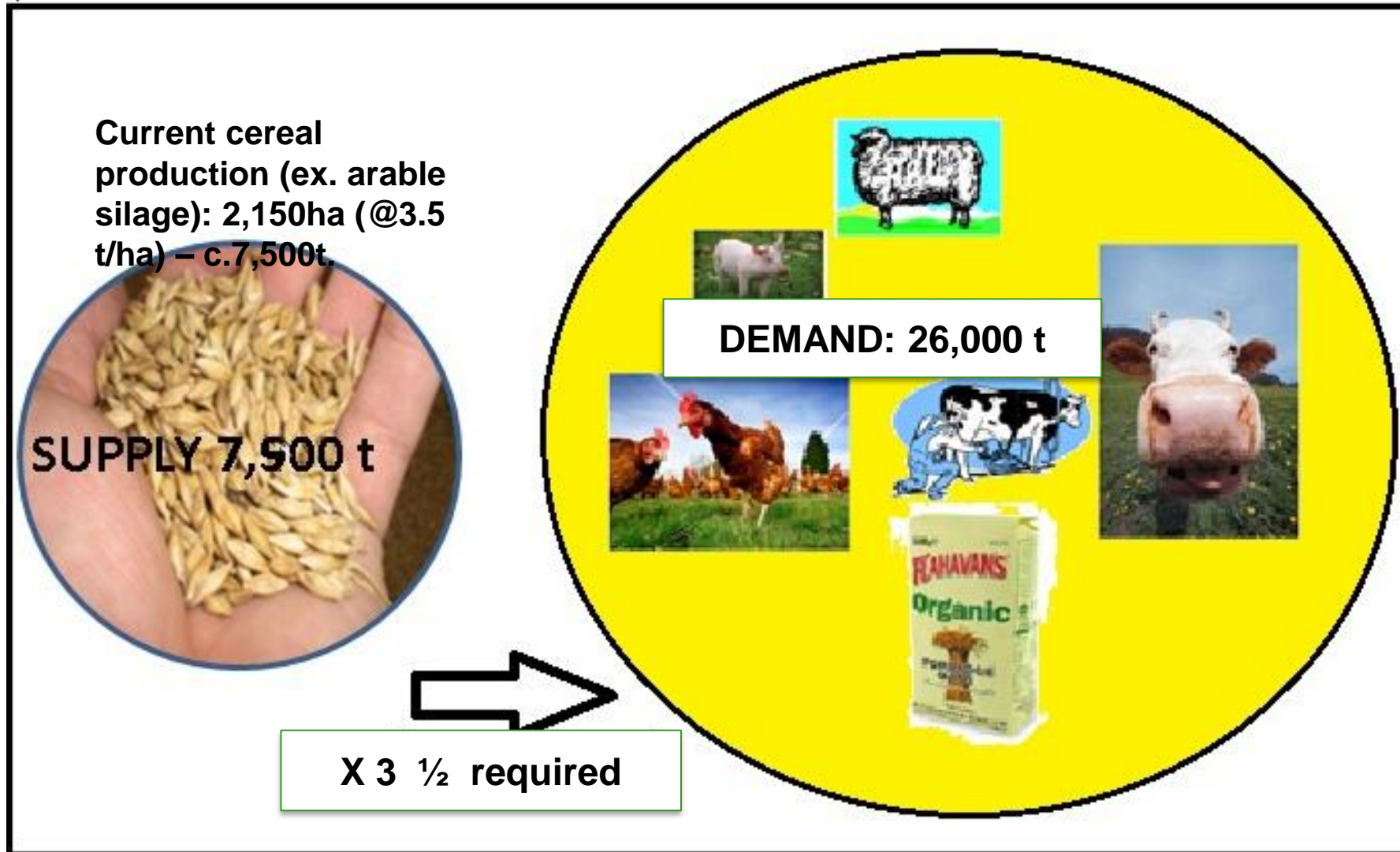

# Supply v Demand: how big is the gap 2018?

- Current cereal production (ex. arable silage): 2,134ha (@3.5 t/ha) – c.7,500t.
- Demand: 7,400ha – c. 26,000t (Teagasc est.)

- Be more self sufficient by growing more organic cereals and pulses



- Requires more protein/legume crops to be also grown in the rotation
